

## PDHPE/Sport Information 2022

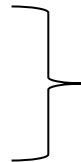
Dear Parents and Caregivers,

During the school year, under normal circumstances; Year 7-11 students will participate in weekly sport whole school carnivals and Year 10 will attend the B streetsmart Road Safety excursion across various locations within the metropolitan area. With each of these activities comes a permission note. To streamline this process for both staff and parents, we are seeking your permission to include your child in all local carnivals and sporting activities.

An information note will be sent out 2 weeks prior to the event outlining purpose, location, student requirements and costs involved. The Swimming Carnival, Cross Country Carnival, Athletics Carnival, Zone Carnivals and the B Streetsmart Road Safety excursion (Year 10 only) are compulsory for all students.

The activities undertaken off the school grounds includes weekly sports lessons, major carnivals and the Road Safety excursion. This note covers all activities of this type for the 2022 school year (it does not include overnight or extended camps).

To qualify for a ROSA each student must complete the required hours in accordance with the NESAs Syllabus and:

1. Participate in ALL PE and Sport lessons. For exemptions from physical activity a legitimate note from parents/caregivers or a Medical Certificate is required.
2. Wear the required PE uniform, (purchased from the school uniform shop) i.e.:
  - School sport polo shirt
  - Black tracksuit
  - Black school sport shorts, black leggings or bike tights without advertising
3. Attend swimming, athletic and cross-country carnivals which are an important part of the school program
4. Attend and participate in integrated sports sessions as per timetabled lessons

PDHPE faculty uniform policy applies to all students. The PDHPE policy states that joggers/sandshoes MUST be worn by ALL students in PE/Sport classes. Vans/Converse are not acceptable footwear as they do not provide appropriate foot/ankle support. A black baseball cap and sunscreen is compulsory for outdoor activities. If this uniform cannot be worn a note from parent/caregiver must be brought with alternative sports gear.
